
Covenant Amendment History



Covenant Vote

- 1. Changing the covenants is not easy.
- 2. By Colorado statute, any amendment to the Ruby Ranch covenants must be approved by 67% of all unit owners. An abstention or failure to vote is the same as a vote against the amendment.
- 3. Our covenants (as amended in 1989) require that ballots be notarized.

Options For Correction

- Approve a Restatement that ratifies the changes made in the 1983
 Restatement as if all of the extra changes had been on the 1982 ballot, and includes all of the subsequent amendments.
- 2. Approve an amended Restatement that makes non-substantive updates to the Covenants, including the extra changes in the 1983 Restatement and all subsequent amendments. Could also reflect shift of responsibilities to Metro District.
- 3. Approve a modernizing amendment and Restatement that could make changes in matters such as business uses, short term rentals, enforcement options and other issues that may be raised.
